## St. John Passion - JS Bach

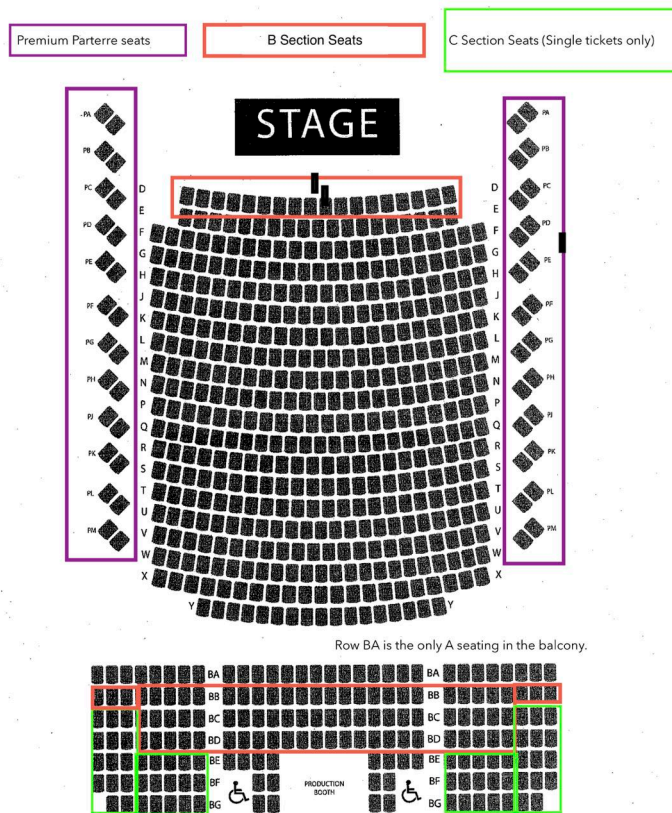
**Sat., March 16, 8 p.m. St. Anne's Church**
